Vaccine & Cost	Dosage
Hepatitis A \$47 per dose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2-dose series • Dose 1 best received at least 2 weeks before travel (lasts up to 1 year) • Dose 2 best received 6-12 months after dose 1 (required for long-term immunity)
Hepatitis B \$55 per dose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3-dose series, best received at 0, 1, and 6 months • Get at least the first 2 doses before travel • Provides lifetime immunity
Hepatitis A and B (Twinrix) \$120 per dose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3-dose series, best received at 0, 1 and 6 months • Doses 1 and 2 best received before travel • Provides lifetime immunity
Influenza \$30	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1-dose vaccination
Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) \$83 per dose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2-dose series
Meningitis \$130	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1-dose vaccination • Protects against 4 of the 5 types of meningitis
Polio \$55	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If immunized in childhood, one booster may be needed as an adult • If not immunized in childhood, a series of 1-3 doses received at 4-week intervals
Rabies \$220 per dose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3-dose series, received over 1 month • Vaccination does not eliminate the need for post-exposure treatment
Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) \$69	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1-dose vaccination
Typhoid Fever	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$78 for vaccine: 1-dose vaccination, best received at least 2 weeks before travel (effective for 2 years) OR • Capsules (4 total, 1 taken every other day, must be refrigerated); effective for 5 years
Yellow Fever \$118	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1-dose vaccination best received at least 10 days before travel • Lasts for 10 years
TB Skin Test (PPD) - \$10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Not a vaccine but a test for infection • Pre-departure test and retest 12 weeks after return may be recommended
